

Declaration of Consent for Data Processing

Final Questionnaire – Dortmund Graduate School of Physics (DGSP)

With this declaration, I consent to the processing of my personal data as described below in connection with the final questionnaire of the Dortmund Graduate School of Physics (DGSP).

The DGSP final questionnaire should be completed after the defense and submitted by e-mail to dekanat.physik@tu-dortmund.de. All information provided in the questionnaire is voluntary. The questionnaire is available on the DGSP website.

Purpose of Data Processing: The information will be used by the Dortmund Graduate School of Physics (DGSP) for internal quality assurance and for long-term statistical analyses. The aim is to further develop doctoral structures and support services. The evaluation is carried out exclusively in aggregated form. Individual assessment or use of data for personnel, supervision, or employment decisions does not take place.

Type of Data Processed: Data relating to the doctoral process are processed, particularly concerning experiences during the doctorate, scientific output, mobility, career planning, as well as optional open feedback.

Legal Basis: Processing is based on my voluntary consent pursuant to Art. 6(1)(a) GDPR.

Withdrawal of Consent: I may withdraw my consent at any time without giving reasons and without any disadvantages, with effect for the future. Withdrawal can be made by e-mail to dekanat.physik@tu-dortmund.de. Already created aggregated statistical evaluations remain unaffected by this withdrawal.

Controlling entity: Responsible is the Technische Universität Dortmund, Organizational unit is the Dortmund Graduate School of Physics.

Recipients of Data: The data will be processed within DGSP, the Faculty of Physics, and Technische Universität Dortmund. Disclosure takes place only in aggregated or anonymized form.

Storage Period: Data will be stored indefinitely for statistical purposes exclusively in aggregated or anonymized form.

Special Categories of Personal Data: Please do not provide any information concerning special categories of personal data within the meaning of Art. 9 GDPR.

Rights: I have the right to access, rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, and data portability within the framework of legal provisions. In addition, I have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority—the State Commissioner for Data Protection and Freedom of Information North Rhine-Westphalia (LDI NRW).
